Entry Rules

1. Tri-County **entry fee** will be **\$2.00 per class**.
2. **Entries close July 8, at 5pm**. Entries made in the wrong class will be disqualified. Entries can be made online at www.saratogacountyfair.org
3. Exhibitors must have a health certificate that has been signed by an accredited veterinarian after May 1 of the current year. Any animal that does not pass the health check will be dismissed from the fairgrounds.
4. Saratoga County Agricultural Society requires all goats to be immunized against **rabies**. A certificate of rabies vaccination, signed by a Category 2 accredited veterinarian, must be presented to gain entrance to the fairgrounds. The rabies vaccine must be administered within the past 12 months.
5. All animals must be dehorned or polled.
6. The Dairy Goat Show is open to all counties.
7. **Out of County herds will be accepted ONLY if space is available. Please contact the superintendent to see if space is available.**
8. Exhibitors participating in the Dairy Goat Show must house their animals on the fairgrounds for the entire week of the Fair.
9. All exhibitors entering the Dairy Goat Show and the ADGA Open Doe Show must see "Rules and Regulations" under Open Doe Show.
10. Exhibitors must bring their goats in on Monday, July 17, from 11am to 4pm.
11. **Tickets:** Each goat exhibitor will receive six (6) free one day admission tickets upon submitting entries, good for one (1) admission per day for the entire week. In addition, each exhibitor will be able to purchase up to two (2) packets of six (6) one day admission tickets for \$25 per packet only at the time of entry. All general re-entry rules will apply with NO exceptions. A one day admission ticket or season ticket allows admission to the grounds ONLY.

A hang tag will be required to park on the grounds.

12. Campground: Exhibitors in this department wishing space for a camper must request so in writing to the fair office on or before June 1, 2017. A limited amount of camper space may be available. Should there be more requests than space available, a committee of the live-stock superintendents will determine, based on need, those who will be offered spots at the exhibitor camping rate, and will notify them by June 16, 2017. Camping spaces are not transferable, and will only be verified with paid entries.
