Entry Fee: Bedspreads, Quilts and Afghans are a flat rate of \$1.50 per entry. All other Home Arts entries are a flat rate of \$0.75 per entry.

Exhibits accepted Friday, July 14, between 5 pm and 7 pm and Saturday, July 15, between 9 am and 3 pm.

Any exhibitor bringing in a large number of entries for Home Arts is encouraged to contact the Superintendent for an advance appointment to drop off exhibits.

Exhibits released Sunday, July 23, between 9 pm and 11pm and Monday, July 24, between 11 am and 5 pm.

All articles exhibited must be made by the exhibitor. No article shall be permitted for competition in this department if it has previously been awarded a prize. Judges will not award a prize where there is no merit. In the event there is no competition in a class, they will award a 1st, 2nd, 3rd premium if, in their judgment, the exhibit deserves it. Soiled or out-of-date articles will not be accepted.

Standards

General Appearance: Article must show good design and color for intended use. Workmanship must be of high quality with attention to details. If an article is an original design, the exhibitor should note this on the entry tag.

On this paper the exhibitor must include the name of the quilt, the name of the maker, the name of the quilter and how the quilting was completed (hand; machine; tied; professional; or any combination thereof). Any quilts made by a Group will need to list the technique(s) used. Any design/pattern source that is totally original (a new creation; not a copy of a previous work; or a pattern not used by another) should be indicated.
