Section 1: School Exhibits/Projects

Parents: If your child has a school project to enter, bring the entry to the Education Department under the Grandstand at the Fairgrounds on Thursday, July 13, between 10am and 2pm.

Entries for this department will be accepted on this date only.

Entries may be removed on Monday, July 24, between 11am and 1pm. Entries left past that time become property of the Saratoga County Fair.

Ribbons will be awarded for all projects.

Three school districts with the best displays will win awards. Art, Social Studies, and Science must be displayed to be eligible for the district award.

Outstanding student awards may be given at the discretion of the judges for the following 9 categories:

Honorable mention awards may be given at the discretion of the judges for Art, Social Studies, Science, Photography, Graphic Arts, and Group Projects.

If they don't, urge them to enter their students' work in the Saratoga County Fair.

Students may enter work on their own.

Section 2: Lego Contest – (LEGO pieces only)
