General Rules

Entries made in the wrong class will be disqualified. Entries can be made online at www.saratogacountyfair.org For more information please contact Crickit Steele-Rockwell at 518-875-6036.

Pre-entries close July 8 at 5pm, must enter minimum of 3 classes to lock in pre entry rate. Payment for classes pre-entered must accompany the pre-entry form(s). All pre-entries must be sent directly to the Fair Entry Office. Pre-entries sent anywhere else will not be honored. There is no pre-entry price difference for Section 1 Gymkhana. Please use a separate entry form for English (Section 2), Gymkhana (Section 1) & Western (Section 3) entries. Make all checks payable to Saratoga County Fair. Payment for classes can be made in cash, by credit card, or by a completely filled out check.

DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES – Entries for the English show will be accepted between 7:00am – 3pm. Gymkhana entries will be accepted between 4:30pm – 9:00pm. Western show entries will be accepted between 7:00am – 3pm. No other entries will be accepted after these times. You may enter up to the start of the second class before your class. (i.e., if you wish to enter class #20, you must have paid for and be entered by the start of class #18. The announcer will close the current class and will not accept any entries for the next two classes). If classes are cancelled or the order changed, you will still have two actual classes to enter. The show committee requests that you alert us to any cancellations.

- 2. A negative Coggins Certificate and a proof of Rabies vaccination is required for each horse. Do not attach Rabies and Coggins papers to your pre-entry. There will be a Fair official at Lot A to check your Rabies and Coggins papers.

 Any horse without R & C papers will be turned away.
- 3. Classes must be paid for as entered and will be final, no refunds under any circumstances.
- 4. The driver of the horse trailer gets in free. One exhibitor per horse is admitted free. Everyone else must pay admission.

Any exhibitor wishing to bring a horse in on Friday night may do so only with advanced permission and arranged prior only with the show superintendent.

Exhibitor will pay non-refundable admission.

Stalls may or may not be available.

Horses will not be allowed to be tied to the trailer overnight.

- 5. AHSA/USEF Rules will be used as a guide for judging all shows. Judges' decision will be final.
- 6. All youth under age 19 as of January 1 of the current year must wear a "properly fitted and secured, officially approved protective helmet at *all* times when mounted on an equine or when seated in a vehicle attached to or being pulled by 1 or more equines or when leading or handling an equine." There will be *no exceptions*!!! All riders regardless of age in classes where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the fairgrounds must wear protective headgear that is securely buckled. Failure to comply with protective headgear rules subjects the violator to possible sanction from the Horse Dept. Committee.

You must wear boots with a well-defined heel and hard sole to ride on equine anywhere on the fairgrounds (no sneakers, sandals or flipflops).

The Saratoga County Fair strongly encourages all non-pro (Amateur) horse show exhibitors over age 19 to wear protective headgear when riding anywhere on the grounds.

- 7. A green horse is defined as a horse or pony of any age in their first or second year of showing. The rider can be any age. Green horses may not cross enter any other division, except for In Hand and Cross Rails.
- 8. Pony height is 14.2 hands and under with a ¼ inch allotment for shoes. Please be accurate in your measurement. Equines entered in the wrong class will be disqualified from that class.
- 9. All horses & ponies that have a tendency to *kick* and **all stallions** <u>must</u> wear a red ribbon in their tail.

 Any exhibitor not complying must forfeit all premiums. For the purpose of safety, the Show Committee reserves the right to disqualify or remove from the ring any horse or pony which is unruly or mishandled.
- 10. No stallions in junior exhibitor classes.
- 11. Walk-Trot, Walk-Jog, and Leadline exhibitors may not enter any other classes except In Hand and Costume.
- 12. Age of exhibitor is calculated on January 1, 2017. Jr. classes are ages 17 & under. Sr. classes are ages 18 & over. Driver's License ID required to show age.
- 13. The Show Committee may add, combine, change order of, or cancel any class as warranted.
- 14. Box stalls will be available at \$15 per day, or \$25.00 per weekend, **paid day of show**. A stall manager will be available to handle stall assignments. Payment for stall must be made at the announcer's stand at time of exhibitor number pickup. **No** bedding will be provided.

One horse/pony per stall.

All stabled horses/ponies must wear halters.

Stalls will be available after 9am on Saturday and on Saturday night for Sunday's show.

Stalls are first come, first serve.

No stalls will be reserved.

Exhibitors are NOT expected to clean their stalls post show.

- 15. No smoking in the barns or tent.
- 16. No dogs, except Service Dogs, will be allowed on the Fairgrounds.
- 17. All tack changes must be told to the announcer at least 2 classes ahead. All changes must be done in the holding ring, and 3 minutes are allowed. Please be ready.
- 18. In the best interest of public and animal safety, any department exhibit and/or show may be cancelled by the Saratoga County Agricultural Society Board of Directors at any time without notice. There will be no refunds of entry fees.

You may compete in only 1 High Point division

Each horse and rider combination will receive a show number, and points will be awarded for each combination.

- W-T-J classes are for beginner riders –not green horses. If you have EVER loped (cantered) in competition at any level, you are NOT allowed to enter this division.
- 19. Classes which count toward High Point English Sr. Exhibitor (ages 18 & over) are: #1 or #2, #6, #12, #17, #22, #29.
- 20. Classes which count toward High Point English Jr. Exhibitor (ages 17 & under) are: #1 or #2, #7, #13, #18, #23, #30.
- 21. Classes which count toward High Point English Pony Exhibitor) are: #3 or #4, #8, #14, #19, #24, #31.
- 22. Classes which count toward High Point English W/T Exhibitor are: #9, #15, #20, #25, #32.
- 23. Classes which count toward High Point Green Horse English Exhibitor are: #1 or #2 **OR** #3 or #4, #10, #16, #21, #26, #33.
- 24. Classes which count toward High Point Western Sr. Exhibitor (ages 18 & over) are: #130 or #131, #136, #147, #152, #157, #165, #172.
- 25. Classes which count toward High Point Western Jr. Exhibitor (ages 17 & under) are: #130 or #131, #137, #148, #153, #158, #166, #173.
- 26. Classes which count toward High Point Western Pony Exhibitor are: #132 or #133, #138, #149, #154, #159, #167, #174.
- 27. Classes which count toward High Point Western W/J Exhibitor are: #140, #150, #155, #160, #168, #175.
- 28. Classes which count toward High Point Green Horse Western Exhibitor are: #130 or #131 **OR** #132 or #133, #141, #151, #156, #161, #169, #176.

- 29. The Horse Show announcer's stand is broadcast on FM radio frequency. You will be able to hear this broadcast on any standard FM radio.
- 30. The time and duration of lunch and breaks will be announced on the show day.

Section 1: Gymkhana

Friday, July 21, 2017 to start at 6:30pm

- 1. Check in will be in Lot E starting at 4:30pm. at the intersection of County Farm Road and Fairground Avenue near the County Jail. Health papers will be checked there. A Fair Official will notify exhibitors when to proceed to show area.
- 2. A *negative* Coggins Certificate and a *proof* of Rabies vaccination is required for each horse. Do *not* attach Rabies and Coggins papers to your pre-entry. Any horse appearing at the gate without R & C papers will be turned away.
- 3. Age of exhibitor is calculated on January 1, 2017. There will be 2 divisions. Classes will be 18 and under and Adult will be 19 and over.
- 4. All youth under the age of 19 as of January 1, 2017 must wear an approved helmet.

5. Entry fees are \$6 per class or \$40 per division plus \$3 timer fee per rider.
